Concerning COVID-19

The City of Richfield has been monitoring the Coronavirus pandemic closely throughout the week. It is recommended that citizens follow the guidelines set forth by the White House and CDC. In addition to these, city officials are following the guidance relayed by the Governor's Office, Lincoln County Office of Emergency Management and South Central Public Health Department.

We are asking that you shelter in place, avoid crowded gatherings, and be diligent with personal hygiene.

A few reminders to follow:

- * Stay home if possible. Practice good hygiene and remember to wash your hands and avoid touching your face. This will help prevent the spread of the virus.

- * If you are feeling ill, follow the advice of your healthcare professional

- * Avoid group gatherings

- * Please do not hoard groceries and household products. It has been relayed that there is no shortage of supplies in the country and taking more than necessary may prevent others in need of obtaining items.

- * Lastly **refrain from flushing any items, other than toilet paper, down the toilet.**

This will keep the city's system operating efficiently.

As of March 26, 2020, the City Office will be closed to the public until further notice.

All other City services will continue.
