

On June 8, 2015, at 7:00 P.M. The City of Richfield held their regular monthly city council meeting.

Agenda: The agenda was approved by Councilman Ron Holland and Maureen Ward as sent out and posted. Motion Carried.

Mayor Charles Buttane called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Councilman Ron Holland, Councilman Danny Ward, Councilman Maureen Ward and Mayor Charles Buttane were in attendance. Councilman Deb Chamberlin was absent.

Employees: Maintenance Supervisor Jason Brauburger was in attendance along with acting City Clerk Lacey Loughmiller due to City Clerk LuAnn Swainston absence.

Guest included Rex Harding JUB Engineer.

Minutes: Councilman Danny Ward made the motion to waive the reading and approve the previous months minutes, 2nd by Councilman Maureen Ward. Motion Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Councilman Maureen Ward made the motion to waive the reading and approve the treasurer's report, 2nd by Councilman Ron Holland. Motion Carried.

Ordinance: Lacey Loughmiller read the preamble of the 2nd reading of the Zoning Ordinance. Councilman Maureen Ward made the motion to approve the 2nd reading, 2nd by Councilman Danny Ward. Motion Carried. 3rd and Final Reading will take place at the next City Council meeting July 13, 2015, at 7:00 P.M.

Old Business: JUB Engineer Rex Harding informed the Mayor and City Council that the new water line that was put in by Jason and Jose is complete; the plan has been submitted to the DEQ.

The City of Richfield received an email with the rough draft of the Source Water Protection Plan from Adriana Hummer from Idaho Rural Water Association. The mayor, city clerk, planning and zoning commission will go through it.

New Business: Mayor Buttane recommended to the city council putting fencing around the 4 wells starting with the Well No. 2 (railroad well). The fencing will be like what is around the water tower. Councilman Danny Ward made the motion to have Jason to get bids from fencing companies, 2nd by Councilman Maureen Ward. Motion Carried.

Robert Luff water line: The city has already fixed several leaks on the water line; the line is in the area of impact. Councilman Holland stated that precedence has been set when Gene Cox purchased the pipe and the city put the line in. Councilman Holland would like to see the same done for Robert Luff. The line is believed to be 1". Councilman Danny made the motion that they buy the pipe and the city would put it in, 2nd by Councilman Holland. Motion Carried.

Mayor Buttane asked suggestions from the city council of Budget Ideas to be written into the Budget for Fiscal Year 2015-2016. The city council had no ideas at the moment but will let the mayor and/or city clerk of items they would like to see done.

The City has not received any information on the Oscar Peterson Memorial from Lawrence Silvey.

Councilman Maureen Ward has made the book on History of Richfield available on PDF format and would like to be able to put a link on the Cities Web site. Jason will talk with Jama Hamel to get it put on the web site.

Bills were read by the acting city clerk Lacey Loughmiller. Councilman Holland made the motion to pay the bills as read, 2nd by Councilman Maureen Ward. Motion Carried.
