

ORDINANCE NO. 153

AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE INTENT TO EXCHANGE CITY PROPERTY AND PROVIDING NOTICE OF HEARING:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD IN LINCOLN COUNTY, IDAHO:

Under the provisions of Idaho Code §50-1403 the Richfield City Council hereby provides notice to the public of its intent to exchange 50' feet of city property in what is known as the Underwood Addition on Lake Avenue, more particularly described as ~~as portions of Block 1, Lots 6 described as follows:~~ SEPARATING  
BLOCK 1 FROM BLOCK 5 TRAVELING 316 ft. WEST FROM MAIN STREET BY A WIDTH OF  
50 ft.

It is the city's intent to exchange said property for the following described property: BLOCK 1---LOTS 6 & 7 OF THE UNDERWOOD  
DIVISION , INCLUDING THE ALLEY.

In addition to this legal property description being published, a map will be available for viewing at the city hall during normal business hours. A public hearing shall be held at the regular council meeting on November 11, 1991, a petition may also be filed with the city clerk by qualified electors expressing views or dissatisfaction with said exchange within 60 days of the passage of this ordinance.

The 9 day of September, 1991 shall be THE EFFECTIVE DATE of this Ordinance.
