

ORDINANCE NO. 154

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY LOCATED NORTH WEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF BLAKE ST. AND KOOTENAI AVE. AND TO INCORPORATE THE SAME WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF IDAHO CODE §50-222:

BE IT ORDAINED by the MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, COUNTY OF LINCOLN, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO:

ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY

There is hereby annexed to the City of Richfield, County of Lincoln, State of Idaho, at the owner's (Don and Cheri Erwin) written request and incorporated within the corporate boundaries thereof, the following territory adjoining the present corporate boundaries of the city and hereafter to be known as the Erwin Annex:

Beginning at the point where Cassia Avenue meets the city limits then run east along Cassia Avenue to the intersection of Cassia Avenue and Blake Street for a distance of 158 feet more or less, Thence south along Blake street for 543 feet more or less to the intersection of Kootenai avenue and Blake Street, Thence west along Kootenai Avenue to the present city limit boundary, Thence north 543 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

The map attached to this ordinance is an accurate map of the territory annexed, and such map is hereby adopted as the official map of the territory annexed, and the Mayor of Richfield is hereby authorized and directed to certify that the map is an accurate map of the territory annexed under the provisions of this ordinance, and to record in the office of the Lincoln County Recorder, in the State of Idaho, this ordinance together with a certified copy of the official map attached.

This ordinance was passed by the Richfield City Council on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1991, and shall take effect on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1992.
