

ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, LINCOLN COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE OF THE NAME OF 4TH STREET IN THE CITY OF RICHFIELD TO TIGER DRIVE, REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and City Council of the City of Richfield, Idaho:

Section 1: That the name of the street now known as "4th Street" in the City of Richfield, Idaho will be changed and it shall be hereinafter known as "Tiger Drive".

Section 2: The location of Tiger Drive will be the same as 4th Street presently exists on the City Plat commencing at Cassia Street, thence south and presently terminating at Lincoln Street. In the event of the future opening of 4th Street, extended, as it now exists on the City Plat, any other portion thereof shall also be known as Tiger Drive.

Section 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, insofar as they are in conflict herewith, be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

Section 4: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect, invalidate, or nullify the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 5: This ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
