

ORDINANCE NO. 179

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, LINCOLN COUNTY, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOGS, AND OTHER ANIMALS, AT OWNER'S EXPENSE IN CERTAIN INSTANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of Richfield, Idaho.

Section 1: That any dog, or other animal, that bites a person or another animal, shall be immediately impounded and the owner of such dog, or other animal, shall be notified within twenty-four (24) hours.

Section 2: Such dog, or other animal, shall be impounded for a maximum period of eleven (11) days at owner's expense.

Section 3: If such dog, or other animal, is not redeemed by the owner within eleven (11) days, the City of Richfield, shall kill said dog, or other animal, and dispose of the carcass in a lawful manner.

Section 4: In the event such dog, or other animal, has to be tested for rabies, or other disease, such testing will be at the owner's expense, and such expense will be an outstanding expense against such owner and the City of Richfield, may sue in civil court for the collection of the same, whether or not the dog, or other animal, is redeemed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be enforced in conjunction with Ordinance no. 164, City of Richfield.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
