

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO, GRANTING THE RICHFIELD CITY COUNCIL AUTHORITY TO SET, BY RESOLUTION, ADDRESSES WITHIN THE RICHFIELD CITY LIMITS AND IMPACT AREA AND ADOPTING THE CITY COUNCIL'S ADDRESSES AS THE OFFICIAL LEGAL ADDRESSES.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Richfield, Idaho, that some individual houses and/or lots are known by several different addresses; and,

WHEREAS, it is vital to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Richfield that there be only one (1) address for each such house and/or lot in order to provide for emergency services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Richfield, Idaho:

Section 1: The City of Richfield, through its Council, shall, by Resolution, have authority to establish addresses within the city limits and impact area of the City of Richfield.

Section 2: All addresses given by the City, including those already existing, shall be considered the official legal address.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
