

ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 164 BY DELETING SECTION 10 OF SAID ORDINANCE AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 10 REQUIRING THAT DOGS SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RUN AT LARGE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Richfield, Idaho:

Section 1: That Richfield City Ordinance No. 164, Section 10, be amended to read as follows:

Section 10: Dogs Running at Large. --It shall be unlawful for any owner, possessor or person who keeps any dog to permit the same to run at large upon the private premises of others or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks, highways, vacant lots, school grounds or other public places within the City. A dog shall be deemed to be running at large when off or away from the premises of the owner, possessor or keeper thereof, and not under the immediate control of such owner, possessor or keeper or his agent or servant or a member of the immediate family, either by leash, cord or chain; provided, however, that any dog on the premises of a City park, or school grounds, must be controlled by a leash not exceeding 10 feet in length held in the hand of the person controlling the dog. Procuring a license and tag shall not authorize the running at large of said dog.

A violation of this Section shall subject the dog to remedies provided in Section 7 of Ordinance No. 164 and the responsible tenant or master shall be guilty of a violation of Ordinance No. 164 and subject to the penalties set forth in Section 15 of Ordinance No. 164.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
