

ORDINANCE NO. 206

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY BOUNDARIES, PROVIDING A DEFINITION, FIXING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING A SAME USE CLAUSE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO:

Section 1: WEAPONS DISCHARGE: It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any weapon, _____, sparrow gun, flipper, firearm or any similar device or contrivance within the limits of the City of Richfield; excepting Police or law enforcement officers in their line of duty.

Section 2: Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine in the maximum amount of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and up to six (6) months in jail, or both.

Section 3: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality will not effect, invalidate, or nullify the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 4: This ordinance shall full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
