

**ORDINANCE NO. 232**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO, SETTING FORTH STANDARDS FOR SNOW REMOVAL:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO:

**SECTION 1:** That the City of Richfield shall plow, at the discretion of the City Superintendent, or such other city official deemed appropriate by the Mayor and/or City Council, snow from the streets of Richfield.

**SECTION 2:** No person shall plow, push or otherwise cause snow accumulations on private property or city rights-of-way to be placed in any public street in the City of Richfield.

**SECTION 3:** The City shall not plow snow on those streets that have vehicles parked in such a way as to make it dangerous, to safely plow the snow from the street.

**SECTION 4:** Any violation this ordinance shall be considered an infraction punishable by a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus court costs.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this ordinance but declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purposes of this ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.

**SECTION 6:** All provisions of the current Municipal Code or ordinances of the City of Richfield which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the City of Richfield, Idaho, in conflict with this ordinance or any part hereof are especially repealed hereby.

**SECTION 6:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
