

ORDINANCE NO. 238

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 76 IN ITS ENTIRETY; PROVIDING HOURS FOR THE SALE OF WINE, BEER, AND ALCOHOL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1:** Richfield City Ordinance No. 76 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- SECTION 2:** The retail sale of beer, wine, and liquor by the drink shall be allowed on Sunday, Memorial Day, and Thanksgiving from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day.
- SECTION 3:** The sale of beer, wine, and liquor shall be allowed from 10:00 a.m. on Friday to 2:00 a.m. on Saturday and from 10:00 a.m. on Saturday to 2:00 a.m. on Sunday.
- SECTION 4:** The City of Richfield adopts all other Idaho State codes and rules regarding the retail sale of beer, wine, and liquor not in conflict with this ordinance.
- SECTION 5:** Any violation of this ordinance shall be considered a misdemeanor punishable pursuant to state law.
- SECTION 6:** This ordinance is hereby declared to be severable. Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall be continue in full force and effect and shall be read to carry out the purposes of this ordinance before the declaration of partial invalidity.
- SECTION 7:** All provisions of the current Municipal Code or ordinances of the City of Richfield which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- SECTION 8:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
