A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE LINCOLN COUNTY EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE AS THE LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENTS OCCURRING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF DECEMBER 12, 1994.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 39-7105 (1) (a) mandates that "the governing body of every City shall designate by Ordinance or Resolution a Local Emergency Response Authority for Hazardous Substance Incidents within its corporate limits"; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Emergency Planning Committee is the most appropriate agency to be designated as a Hazardous Material Response Authority, having trained personnel and appropriate equipment; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHFIELD, IDAHO THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Lincoln County Emergency Planning Committee is hereby designated by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Richfield, to be the Emergency Response Authority for Hazardous Material Incidents that occur within the corporate limits of the City of Richfield.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
